Truck drivers in the forest industry may operate tractor-trailer combination or dump trucks to haul wood products; chips, logs, and other forest products to and from facilities. Drivers are required to have a commercial driver's licenses and must maintain a clean driving record. They may work directly for forest products companies or they may be self-employed.
