

Millwright

Millwright, or Industrial Mechanic, is a tradesperson who installs, maintains, and repairs stationary industrial machinery and mechanical equipment. They interpret drawings, follow layouts, and assemble parts until they are in perfect working order. Industrial mechanics and millwrights may be cross-trained in a second trade, such as pipefitting, welding, machining or electrical maintenance.

Other job titles include: Maintenance Technician, Precision Millwright and Reliability Technician.
